Deadline of the Call : date 15 month 4 year 2015

Guideline of the Call (title, abstract, full papers, limit of words, etc.) :

Current contributions focus strongly on colonial and immediate post-colonial Indonesia, embracing both economic factors (profits for private, economic growth performance in the host country) and social repercussions of the presence of foreign firms (in particular for indigenous society). Papers adopting a comparative perspective across nations in Southeast Asia are especially welcome. Please send a paper title and an abstract no later than the deadline of this call.

Remarks (number of expected acceptances, intent, purpose, etc.) :

This session at the International Economic History Congress forms a follow-up to a pre-conference meeting held at Leiden in the Netherlands on 16-17 December in which 10 papers were presented. Several of the participants are expected to present revised and updated versions at the session in Kyoto. Final aim is to work towards a collective volume on this topic.
