Please submit the title of your proposed paper, extended abstract (1-2 pages), and full contact information to the session organizer before December 31st 2014.

Following organizers' instructions, full papers (8,000 words) or long abstracts should be sent before 30 April 2015.

Remarks (number of expected acceptances, intent, purpose, etc.) :

The overall aim of this session is to contribute to an in-depth historical and institutionally oriented qualitative analysis of FDI and MNEs spillovers on host economies, by promoting a multidisciplinary, comparative and transcontinental scholarly dialogue. Therefore, we invite scholars to submit proposals for papers that provide new empirical evidence, which are built on a sound theoretical and methodological basis to revisit these issues. We welcome in particular papers dealing with FDI flows before WWII and in the service sector (a period and a sector usually neglected by the traditional international business literature). Especially questions related to spillovers from FDI and their effects on local institutional context, local talent and MNEs' entry strategy are welcome, but any other issue related to the call for papers theme will be also considered. We will limit the number of participants in order to ensure adequate time for discussion and debate.
