Guideline of the Call (title, abstract, full papers, limit of words, etc.) :

By April 1, we expect a full paper, or an extended draft with a maximum length of 10,000 words. Full papers may be longer.

In order to broaden the range of nationalities of the prospective participants, papers can be submitted in English, Spanish, Portuguese, or French.

Remarks (number of expected acceptances, intent, purpose, etc.) :

This session offers an excellent opportunity for those researchers willing to share concepts, sources, methods and results with other colleagues interested in long-term and cross-country comparative studies on welfare, inequality and living standards in America, Asia and Europe, from 1500 to present. This session aims at deepening the productive discussions held in the IV Congress of Latin American Economic History (Bogotá, Colombia, July 2014), as well as at expanding their geographical scope as to include other European countries and Asia into a more global perspective. You are, then, kindly invited to submit a proposal to take part in it.

It is highly desirable that participants try to use methods, or produce data, that is suitable for comparison.
