Besides the papers to be presented by the already announced participants, we intend to accept about 4-6 additional papers which will contribute to one or more of the following issues:

- "historical experiences" of sharing the costs of higher education between individuals, the state and/or the market;
- economic and social consequences of the various models of institutional arrangements in higher education, ranging from the self-regulatory system only loosely related to the economy (associated foremost with the so-called Humboldtian model of university) to centrally-regulated (typical for so-called communist system) and to the currently expanding self-regulated market-oriented system;
- impact of various models of higher education at macro and institutional level and how such correlation has been reflected in policy development.
