Title: Demographic differentials by wealth and status

■ Call for Papers

Deadline of the Call : date 1 month 2 year 2015

Guideline of the Call (title, abstract, full papers, limit of words, etc.) :

This session aims at comparing patterns of differentials in demographic behavior by wealth and occupational status in 18th, 19th and early 20th century Europe, Asia, North America and elsewhere. Demographic outcomes to be considered include mortality, marriage, reproduction and migration. Wealth measures include wages, landholding and property. Status measures include occupation and hereditary membership in state-imposed population categories. We especially welcome papers making use of quantitative approaches and individual-level data to ensure the comparability of the results and stimulate panel discussion. The focus is on identifying common patterns that reflected shared features of economic, political and social context, and distinctive patterns associated with specific features of local context.

Paper proposals can be submitted no later than February 1, 2015, and should at least include the title and a 300-word abstract. Extended abstracts (2-4 pages) or full manuscripts are especially welcome.

Remarks (number of expected acceptances, intent, purpose, etc.) :

We expect to recruit a total of 6 papers. Decisions will be made by February 20, 2015.
